

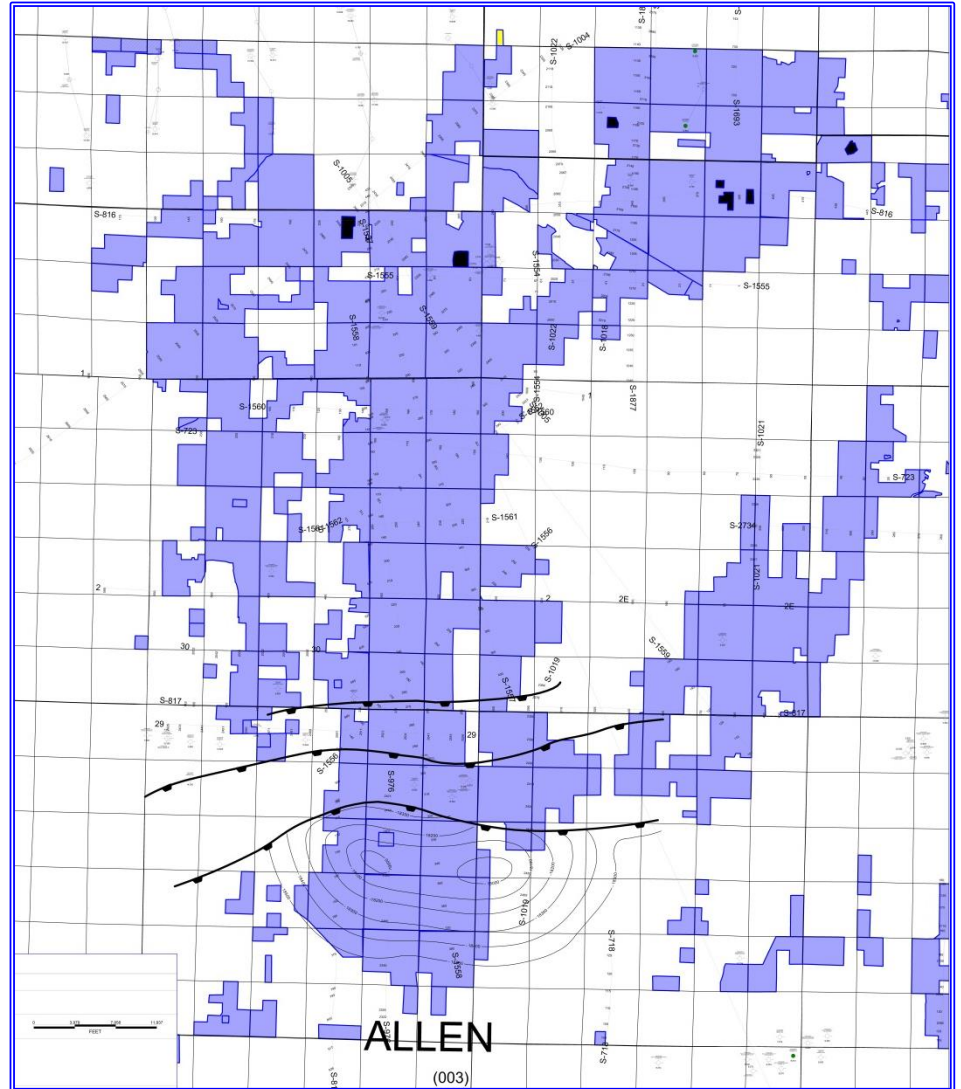
# 70,000 ACRE BLOCK – ALLEN PH., LA YEGUA, WILCOX, AND CRETACEOUS POTENTIAL

Located on and south of the Cretaceous shelf edge, where turbidities of Tuscaloosa age could be deposited seaward of the shelf edge, similar to fields in southeastern Louisiana. Fracturing of the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale may also be prevalent on the Sligo shelf.

Numerous 2D lines traversing the acreage are available for review on a Kingdom work station in our Houston office. These lines show a large regional unconformity.

Rollover features associated with faulting are also present at depth in the central and southern portion of the block.
